### Club Rules, Terms & Conditions.

#### Club Fees

Adult and childrens fees are payable by monthly standing order at the level listed on our website [www.atemijujitsu.com](http://www.atemijujitsu.com). Please ask your instructor if you do not have access to the internet and they will provide you with a printed version.

This monthly fee entitles you to either one training session a week or unlimited training sessions a week depending on the fee you pay. There are seven adult sessions and two kids sessions a week, **a week being Monday to Sunday**. If you have opted for one lesson a week and you miss your chosen training night/ session, then you are entitled to any other available session free of charge within that week. **Unattended sessions are not cumulative.**

#### Gradings

All fees will be paid a week prior to grading, if a student does not attend their grading as agreed it will be classed as a fail.

If an injury occurs which prevents a student from continuing it will be classed as a fail for both students. Part of a students grading is to show respect and control at all times. Licence must be valid to grade. Grading levels are Pass, First Class and First Class Plus.

#### Attendance

Students are expected to train on a regular basis. If more than four weeks are missed consecutively **without a valid reason given to your Sensei**, prior to recommencement of training, the student will be downgraded by two belts (grades) and licences will not automatically be renewed. If wanting to return a student will have to demonstrate to the Sensei that they are serious about practicing the art before they have an opportunity to regrade. If their licence has expired they will have to reapply at full cost.

#### Licence and Insurance Renewal

It is the responsibility of the STUDENT to ensure that their licence is passed to their Sensei for renewal two weeks PRIOR to expiry. Unless there are very exceptional circumstances, uninsured students will not be able to take part in the lesson. Insurance is not only to cover you for injury but should be out of respect for your fellow students who may be injured through your actions.

#### Injuries

All injuries should be reported immediately to the Senior Instructor taking the class and recorded in the club accident book. Serious injuries should also be reported by the Senior Instructor to a representative of Sidcup Rugby Club. This is essential should an insurance claim be required.

#### Damage and Theft

Any damage to property or equipment and theft of club or personal belongings should be reported as above, however responsibilities lies solely with the student.

#### General

Every club member must adhere to the rules above and show commitment, respect and responsibility for both themselves and others.
